THE GOSPEL READING

THE NICENE CREED

THE WORDS OF INSTITUTION

Celebrant: On the night that he was betrayed, our Lord Jesus Christ took bread; and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying, "Take, eat; this is my Body which is given for you: Do this in remembrance of me."

Likewise, after supper, Jesus took the cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, saying, "Drink this, all of you; for this is my Blood of the New Covenant, which is shed for you, and for many, for the forgiveness of sins: Whenever you drink it, do this in remembrance of me."

Therefore we proclaim the mystery of faith:

Christ has died.

Christ is risen.

Christ will come again.

THE MINISTRATION OF COMMUNION

Celebrant: The gifts of God for the people of God. Take them in remembrance that Christ died for you, and feed on him in your hearts by faith with thanksgiving.

We invite you to take advantage of several opportunities:

All baptized Christians of any age are welcome and encouraged to receive communion. The clergy will celebrate the Eucharist in both kinds while distributing only the bread to the congregation. Gluten free bread is available also. We ask that households maintain social distance with one another when coming forward to receive the sacrament. While not the norm or the ideal, this practice of the laity receiving only the bread for a season has ample historical precedent and fully confers to its recipients the real presence of Christ.

MISSION TEAMS

- **Angel Wings:** The Angel Wings Mission Team provides meals to those who are going through trying times, such as the birth of a new baby, hospitalization, a death in the family, etc. All are welcome to participate. For more information or to get involved, contact Team Leader Carrie Setterberg.
- **Community Pregnancy Center of Lake Norman:** The Community Pregnancy Center of Lake Norman (www.lakenormancpc.org) is a non-profit, inter-denominational ministry that seeks to serve Jesus Christ through ministering to those touched by possible crisis pregnancy, including the woman and her unborn child, by providing emotional and material support, as well as the personal knowledge of the grace and love of the Living Lord. They provide peer counseling, education, and support services using staff, trained volunteers and lay counselors, with the assistance of individuals and churches within the community. - **Davidson College:** The Davidson College mission team exists to share life in Christ with Davidson College students by pairing a Good Shepherd family with an "adopted" Davidson student. They will pray for, encourage, and express the hospitality of Christ to these students as they integrate into the Good Shepherd family during their time at Davidson. - **Refugee Support Services:** The RSS mission team seeks to embody God's heart for the refugee community of Charlotte. We do this through partnership with Refugee Support Services, a non-profit that helps refugees thrive.
