SERMON

Leader: We pray to you, O God. **People: Lord, hear our prayer.**

Leader: For all baptized Christians, especially those of this parish, that they may discern their vocation to spread the Gospel at all times and in all places.

(Let us pause in Prayer)

Leader: We pray to you, O God. **People: Lord, hear our prayer.**

Leader: For all who have not yet heard or believed in the Gospel, and those who may have the opportunity to declare it to them.

(Let us pause in Prayer)

Leader: We pray to you, O God. **People: Lord, hear our prayer.**

Leader: For an increase in evangelism and ministries of mercy in our local community and abroad, such as the Community Pregnancy Center of Lake Norman, Flourish Kenya, and Land of 1000 Hills, that all people may come to know and enjoy your blessings, and for greater awareness and advocacy on behalf of the persecuted churches.

(Let us pause in Prayer)

Leader: We pray to you, O God. **People: Lord, hear our prayer.**

Leader: For all people driven from their homes by war, violence, and natural disaster and for the nations who receive them that you may provide, protect, and care for them, especially for those served by the Refugees. Immigrants, and Displaced Ministry Team.

(Let us pause in Prayer)

Leader: We pray to you, O God. **People: Lord, hear our prayer.**

Leader: For the poor, the hungry, and the oppressed people of the world; for the sick and infirm and those who minister to them, especially for those serving with the Angel's Wings ministry, and for all who suffer for the sake of the Gospel.

(Let us pause in Prayer)

Leader: We pray to you, O God. **People: Lord, hear our prayer.**

Leader: For those among us who are feeling weary, burdened, and heavy laden.

(Let us pause in Prayer)

Leader: We lift our concerns to you, O God.

People: Lord, hear our prayer.

Leader: In thanksgiving for all who have died in the hope of the Resurrection, and those whose faith is known to you alone.

(Let us pause in Prayer)

Leader: We pray to you, O God. **People: Lord, hear our prayer.**

Leader: For yours is the majesty, O Father, Son, and Holy Spirit; yours is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, now and forever. **AMEN!**

THE CONFESSION OF SIN (from the Anglican prayers of Kenya)

Celebrant: Let us now come before the Lord and make confession of our sins, lifting our hearts to Him in humility and repentance.

Most merciful God, we confess that we have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done, and by what we have left undone. We have not loved you with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We are truly sorry and we humbly repent. THE NICENE CREED

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, visible and invisible.

We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one Being with the Father; through him all things were made. THE PRAYER OF CONSECRATION

Holy and gracious Father: In your infinite love you made us for yourself; and when we had sinned against you and become subject to evil and death, you, in your mercy, sent your only Son Jesus Christ into the world for our salvation. By the Holy Spirit and the Virgin Mary he became

flesh and dwelt among us. In obedience to your will, he stretched out his arms upon the Cross and offered himself once for all, that by his suffering and death we might be saved. By his resurrection he broke the bonds of death, trampling Hell and Satan under his feet. As our great high priest, he ascended to your right hand in glory, that we might come with confidence before the throne of grace.

On the night that he was betrayed, our Lord Jesus Christ took bread; and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying, "Take, eat; this is my Body, which is given for you: Do this in remembrance of me."

Likewise, after supper, Jesus took the cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, saying, "Drink this, all of you; for this is my Blood of the New Covenant, which is shed for you, and for many, for the forgiveness of sins: Whenever you drink it, do this in remembrance of me." Therefore we proclaim the mystery of faith:

Christ has died.

Christ is risen.

Christ will come again.

We celebrate the memorial of our redemption, O Father, in this sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving, and we offer you these gifts.

Sanctify them by your Word and Holy Spirit to be for your people the Body and Blood of your Son Jesus Christ. Sanctify us also, that we may worthily receive this holy Sacrament, and be made one body with him, that he may dwell in us and we in him. In the fullness of time, put all things in subjection under your Christ, and bring us with all your saints into the joy of your heavenly kingdom, where we shall see our Lord face to face.

All this we ask through your Son Jesus Christ: By him, and with him, and in him, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all honor and glory is yours, Almighty Father, now and forever. **Amen**.
