PRAYERS OF THE PEOPLE

Reader As we come together as a family in Christ, let us give thanks to the Lord for His kindness and mercy to us and our families. As we do, we remember and pray for all people in every land and nation who are suffering from war, injustice, and oppression. We pray for the weak, vulnerable, and scared. We pray for all living in darkness, enslaved by the lusts of this world, and held captive by the evil powers of the devil.

Reader Lord, we pray, be with them.

People **Hear the cry of their hearts.**

Reader Heavenly Father, on this Memorial Day, we remember before You with grateful hearts the men and women of our armed forces, who in the day of decision courageously chose to fight for the liberties we now enjoy. As we honor and mourn the U.S. military personnel who died while serving, we pray for their families and loved ones and ask You to comfort their hearts through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Reader We remember in prayer the leaders of nations; for those in authority, and for all in public service. We pray in particular for the leaders of our community, state, and nation; and we pray for all those who risk their lives for our peace and safe-keeping: Our military, police, fire-workers; medical and first response teams.

Reader Lord, we pray, be with them.

People **Protect them, keep them safe, and give them wisdom.**

Reader We pray together for Your Church here and abroad; for all who call on Your name; for pastors, leaders, missionaries, and their families. We pray for those persecuted for their faith in Jesus Christ and for all who've drifted away and fallen prey to the culture. Lord, we pray for our church family here at Good Shepherd; be with each of us and our families; our bishops, vestry, staff, search team, and all who serve. We also pray for our new pastor and his family, whoever that might be.

Reader Lord, we pray, be with Your Church.

People **Protect us, guide us, and empower us for Your service.**

Reader Heavenly Father, we lift to You the burdens each of us carry on our hearts. We lift to You those we love who are in need today; for the sick and suffering of heart, body, and soul. We remember those grieving loss and for those among our family and friends who don't know Your Son, Jesus Christ, as their Savior.

Reader Lord, we pray, be with us.

People **Open our hearts to receive Your healing and love.**

Celebrant Remaining in prayer, let us now come before the Lord and confess our sins, lifting our hearts to Him in humility and repentance.

THE PRAYER OF CONSECRATION

Holy and gracious Father: In Your infinite love You made us for Yourself; and when we had sinned against you and become subject to evil and death, you, in Your mercy, sent Your only Son Jesus Christ into the world for our salvation. By the Holy Spirit and the Virgin Mary He became flesh and dwelt among us. In obedience to Your will, He stretched out His arms upon the Cross and offered Himself once for all, that by His suffering and death we might be saved.

Together **By His resurrection He broke the bonds of death, trampling Hell and Satan under His feet. As our great high priest, He ascended to your right hand in glory, that we might come with confidence before the throne of grace.**

On the night that He was betrayed, our Lord Jesus Christ took bread; and when He had given thanks, He broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying, “Take, eat; this is My Body, which is given for you: Do this in remembrance of Me.”

Likewise, after supper, Jesus took the cup, and when He had given thanks, He gave it to them, saying, “Drink this, all of you; for this is My Blood of the New Covenant, which is shed for you, and for many, for the forgiveness of sins: Whenever you drink it, do this in remembrance of Me.”

Therefore, we proclaim the mystery of faith:

Together **Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again.**

We celebrate the memorial of our redemption, O Father, in this sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving, and we offer You these gifts.

Sanctify them by Your Word and Holy Spirit to be for Your people the Body and Blood of Your Son Jesus Christ. Sanctify us also, that we may worthily receive this holy Sacrament, and be made one body with Him, that He may dwell in us and we in him. In the fullness of time, put all things in subjection under Your Christ, and bring us with all Your saints into the joy of Your heavenly kingdom, where we shall see our Lord face to face.

Together **All this we ask through Your Son Jesus Christ: By Him, and with Him, and in Him, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all honor and glory is Yours, Almighty Father, now and forever. Amen.**
