## SERMON

### PRAYERS OF THE PEOPLE

*Reader* As we come together as a family in Christ, let us give thanks to the Lord for His kindness and mercy to us and our families. As we do, we remember and pray for all people in every land and nation who are suffering from war; injustice, and oppression. We pray, as we come to World Refugee Day, for the ministry of Refugee Support Services here in Charlotte. Heavenly Father, we ask You to pour out Your grace, mercy, and compassion on the refugees and asylees among us. Provide for their needs, heal their wounds, and help them to know Your nearness and care. Give us a heart to serve those in our community who have been exiled from their homes and increase in us a love for those who suffer from homelessness and loneliness.

*(we pause in prayer...)*

*Reader* Lord, we pray, be with them.

**People** **Hear the cry of their hearts.**

*Reader* We remember in prayer the leaders of nations; for those in authority, and for all in public service. We pray in particular for the leaders of our community, state, and nation; and we pray for all those who risk their lives for our peace and safe-keeping: Our military, police, fire-workers; medical and first response teams.

*(we pause in prayer...)*

*Reader* Lord, we pray, be with them.

**People** **Protect them, keep them safe, and give them wisdom.**

*Reader* On this Father's Day, we thank You for the Dad's and Grandad's in our church family and pray your blessing on them today. And for our church family here at Good Shepherd, we pray you'd be with each one of us and our families; our vestry – and the election of new vestry; our staff; our search team; and all who serve so faithfully week after week. We pray for our new pastor and his family, whoever that might be, as well as for a new worship pastor. This week we also pray for the election of a new Archbishop.

*Reader* Lord, we pray, be with Your Church.

**People** **Protect us, guide us, and empower us for Your service.**

*Reader* Heavenly Father, we lift to You the burdens each of us carry on our hearts. We lift to You those we love who are in need today; for the sick and suffering of heart, body, and soul. We remember those grieving loss and for those among our family and friends who don't know Your Son, Jesus Christ, as their Savior.

THE PRAYER OF CONSECRATION
