## SERMON

## PRAYERS OF THE PEOPLE

*Reader* Lord, we pray, be with them.

***People*** **Hear the cry of their hearts.**

*Reader* We remember in prayer the leaders of nations; for those in authority, and for all in public service. We pray in particular for the leaders of our community, state, and nation; and we pray for all those who risk their lives for our peace and safe-keeping: Our military, police, fire-workers; medical and first response teams.

*(we pause in prayer...)*

*Reader* Lord, we pray, be with them.

***People*** **Protect them, keep them safe, and give them wisdom.**

*Reader* We pray together for Your Church here and abroad; for all who call on Your name; for pastors, leaders, missionaries, and their families. We pray for those persecuted for their faith in Jesus Christ and for all who've drifted away and fallen prey to the culture. Lord, we pray for our church family here at Good Shepherd; be with each of us and our families; our bishops, vestry, staff, search team, and all who serve. We pray for our new pastor and his family, whoever that might be. Bless them today and guide them to us. We also pray for a new worship pastor as well as the election of new vestry members. *(we pause in prayer...)*

*Reader* Lord, we pray, be with Your Church.

**People** **Protect us, guide us, and empower us for Your service.**

*Reader* Heavenly Father, we lift to You the burdens each of us carry on our hearts. We lift to You those we love who are in need today; for the sick and suffering of heart, body, and soul. We remember those grieving loss and for those among our family and friends who don't know Your Son, Jesus Christ, as their Savior.  
*(we pause in prayer...)*

*Reader* Lord, we pray, be with us.

**People** **Open our hearts to receive Your healing and love.**

*Celebrant* Remaining in prayer, let us now come before the Lord and confess our sins, lifting our hearts to Him in humility and repentance.

#### THE CONFESSION OF SIN

**Father in heaven, we come to You in the name of Jesus, Your beloved Son, and confess our sins to You *(we pause in prayer...)*. #### THE PRAYER OF CONSECRATION

Almighty God and Father, Creator of all things, in these last days You have sent us Your Son, Your perfect image, bringing Your kingdom, revealing Your will, dying, rising, reigning, and remaking Your people for Yourself.

***Together***      **Through Him You have poured out Your Holy Spirit, filling us with light and life.**

We thank You for giving up Your only Son to die on the cross for us who owe You everything. Pour Your refreshing Spirit on us and upon these gifts as we remember Him in the way He commanded, through these gifts of Your creation. On the same night that He was betrayed He took bread and gave You thanks; He broke it and gave it to His disciples saying, “Take, eat; this is My body which is given for you.
