public service. We pray in particular for the leaders of our community, state, and nation; and we pray for all those who risk their lives for our peace and safe-keeping: Our military, police, fire-workers; medical and first response teams. (we pause in

prayer...)

Reader Lord, we pray, be with them.

People Protect them, keep them safe, and give them wisdom.

Reader We pray together for Your Church here and abroad; for all who call on Your name;

for pastors, leaders, missionaries, and their families. We pray for those persecuted for their faith in Jesus Christ and for all who've drifted away and fallen prey to the culture. Lord, we pray for our church family here at Good Shepherd; be with each of us and our families; our bishops, vestry, staff, search team, and all who serve. We pray for our new pastor and his family, whoever that might be. Bless them today

and guide them to us. (we pause in prayer...)

THE PRAYER OF CONSECRATION

Almighty God and Father, Creator of all things, in these last days You have sent us Your Son, Your perfect image, bringing Your kingdom, revealing Your will, dying, rising, reigning, and remaking Your people for Yourself.

Together Through Him You have poured out Your Holy Spirit, filling us with light and life.

We thank You for giving up Your only Son to die on the cross for us who owe You everything. Pour Your refreshing Spirit on us and upon these gifts as we remember Him in the way He commanded, through these gifts of Your creation.
