SERMON

Reader Lord, we pray, protect them and keep them safe.

People Grant them wisdom that we may live in peace.

- Reader We pray blessing and protection on Your Church here and abroad; for all Christians, pastors, and missionaries who faithfully bear witness to Your Name. Continue to bless us at Good Shepherd. Empower our bishops, vestry, staff, and the ministries You've entrusted to each one of us. And today, we pray special blessing on our new pastor David, his wife Lisa, and their two daughters Abbie and Natalie, especially during this time of transition. Keep them healthy and well. (we pause in prayer...)
- *Reader* Lord, we pray, be present in Your Church.

People Protect us, guide us, and empower us for Your service.

- *Reader* Heavenly Father, You know the burdens of our heart, and we give them to You. We pray for our sick and those we love who are suffering in heart, body, and soul. We lift them now to You by name... (we pause in prayer...)
- *Reader* Lord, we pray, grant them Your mercy.

People Open our hearts to receive Your healing and love.

Reader Yours, O Lord, is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty.

Together For everything in heaven and on earth is Yours; Yours is the Kingdom, O Lord, and You are exalted as Head above all. All things come from You, O Lord, and of Your own have we given You.

Celebrant Remaining in prayer, let us now come before the Lord and confess our sins, lifting our hearts to Him in humility and repentance.

THE PRAYER OF CONSECRATION

Almighty God and Father, Creator of all things, in these last days You have sent us Your Son, Your perfect image, bringing Your kingdom, revealing Your will, dying, rising, reigning, and remaking Your people for Yourself.

Together Through Him You have poured out Your Holy Spirit, filling us with light and life.

We thank You for giving up Your only Son to die on the cross for us who owe You everything. Pour Your refreshing Spirit on us and upon these gifts as we remember Him in the way He commanded, through these gifts of Your creation. On the same night that He was betrayed He took bread and gave You thanks; He broke it and gave it to His disciples saying, "Take, eat; this is My body which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of Me."

Together Amen. His body was broken for us.
